CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard J. Baughman, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and sprinkler system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SW¼ Section 9, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S¼ corner of said Section 9 bears S. 44°17'58" E., a distance of 1,266.80 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Joseph W. McNamee
Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.03 c.f.s., but not to exceed 15.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*April 5, 1943

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

3.0 acres in the SE¼ SW¼ of Section 9, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.


\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 50477, which changed the place of use of a portion of Permit 10940, Certificate 4402; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 10940, Certificate 4402.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
