CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Gregory J. Walch, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for industrial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T.22S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 26 bears N. 63°30'54" E., a distance of 2,863.18 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Industrial and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.02 c.f.s., but not to exceed 6.70 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*April 24, 1947

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 670 feet deep, 10 3/4 inch diameter casing, equipped with a five stage submersible pump with a 100 H.P. motor, thence through a distribution system to a 70,000 gallon storage tank for a sand and gravel operation, and a 30,000 gallon storage tank for a concrete batch plant located within all the land lying East of the Union Pacific Railroad right of way, within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, T.22S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, T.22S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of Permit 11834, Certificate 4069, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11834, Certificate 4069.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
