CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Ronald Cerri, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an improved spring (Eagle Creek Spring), through a pipe and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 5, T.43N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 1, T.43N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 68°44' W., a distance of 10,973.0 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring, through 20 feet of 1" steel pipe and 9,240 feet of 1" plastic pipe, to two Powder River troughs, where 500 head of cattle water within NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 1, T.43N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M.,

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
