CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Samuel R. Clark, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Daisy Creek, springs and tributaries, flood and unappropriated waters, through the Clark Ditch, for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ Section 22, T.28N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 34, T.28N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 03°28'20" W., a distance of 14,608.7 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

0.27 acres in the NW¼SE¼ Section 9, T.28N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M.
14.86 acres in the SW¼SE¼ Section 9, T.28N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M.
15.13 acres total

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
