CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, F. Scott Egbert, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from West Spring (an improved spring), spring box, pipeline, trough and pond for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 2, T.37N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 31, T.37N., R.66E., bears N. 89°30' E., a distance of 12,550 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: F. Scott Egbert and Laurel S. Egbert

Source: West Spring

Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.0266 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 850 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 7, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring through a 3 x 3 x 3-foot spring box thence through approximately 60 feet of 2 inch galvanized pipe to a 400 gallon tank that overflows to a pond that is 65 feet long, 60 feet wide and 6 feet deep where 850 cattle water in the NW¼ NE¼ Section 2, T.37N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Big Springs Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
