CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Outhouse Spring, an unimproved spring and natural channel for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ Section 32, T.44N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 32 bears S. 34°48' E., a distance of 3,302 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Outhouse Spring
Manner of Use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0094 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	October 29, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an unimproved spring through a natural channel where 300 cattle water in the SW¼ NE¼ and NW¼ SE¼ Section 32, T.44N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Salmon River Allotment.


This certificate is issued subject to the State Engineer's Ruling #4705 dated March 1, 1999.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
