CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Coyote Hole Spring, an improved spring, pipeline, two troughs and a pond for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 36, T.43N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 36 bears S. 24°45' E., a distance of 4,650 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Salmon River Cattlemen's Association, Inc.

Source: Coyote Hole Spring

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.0094 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: October 29, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring through buried, 2-inch, perforated plastic pipe thence by pipeline to two troughs with overflow to a small earthen pond where 300 cattle water in the NW¼ NE¼ Section 36, T.43N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Salmon River Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the State Engineer's Ruling #4705 dated March 1, 1999.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
