## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Edward F. Kolojay, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 6, T.25S., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the Northeast corner of said Section 6, bears N. 81° 06' 55" E., a distance of 1161.0 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of Use:	Commercial
Amount of appropriation:	0.010 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.02 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	May 25, 1994

## Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 140 feet deep, 8 5/8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3 H.P. submersible pump through two pressure tanks, thence to five commercial offices in a small shopping center located on Assessor's Parcel Number 219-06-501-017 being within the NE¼ NE¼ of Section 6, T.25S., R.57E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
