CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, James F. Etcheverry, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring (gravel pit) for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 1, Section 31, T.23N., R.52E., M.D.B.& M., (partially unsurveyed) or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 31, bears S. 47°00'55" W., a distance of 6,191.66 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **Eureka Livestock Co.**

Source: **Unnamed spring (gravel pit)**

Manner of Use: **Stockwater**

Amount of appropriation: **0.01 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle and 1600 sheep and lambs**

Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st of each year**

Date of priority of appropriation: **March 12, 1981**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water collects in three shallow excavations (gravel pits) where 100 cattle and 1600 sheep and lambs water in Lot 1, Section 31, T.23N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M. (partially unsurveyed) being within the Roberts Mountain Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
