CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Michael A. Casey, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, and portable stock troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 24, T.19N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 24 bears N 62°20'09" E a distance of 2290.89 feet, situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of Use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.031 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1000 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	January 12, 2000

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 620 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a generator-powered, 1.5 H.P. submersible pump, thence to seven portable 1000-gallon troughs where 1000 head of cattle water in the NW¼ NE¼ Section 24, T.19N., R.37E., being within the Clan Alpine Allotment, Churchill County, Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
