CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, James L. Wade, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Gourd Spring for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 29, T.11S., R.69E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 35, T.11S., R.69E., bears S. 70°57'41" E., a distance of 17,110 feet, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **Lavar and Kaye Wade; and Ed and Connie Bundy**

Source: **Gourd Spring**

Manner of Use: **Stockwater**

Amount of appropriation: **0.0016 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle**

Period of use: **October 1st to June 1st of each year**

Date of priority of appropriation: **August 3, 2001**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Gourd Spring via a concrete headhouse and is conveyed approximately 100 feet via a buried 1-inch black plastic pipe to a 5000 gallon stock watering ring where 50 head of cattle water in the NE¼ NE¼ Section 29 and the SE¼ Section 20, T.11S., R.69E., being within the Gourd Spring Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
