CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Basil Monroe, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 18, bears S. 68°09'18" W., a distance of 2,847.29 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Commercial and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.10 c.f.s., but not to exceed 3.40 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	January 14, 1994

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 110 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump and pressure tank, thence to a church with landscaping located within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 36-231-13, Nye County, Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
