CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert L. Vaught, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mikulich Spring for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ NW¼ (Tract 44) Section 11, T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the GLO brass cap ¼ corner common to Sections 10 and 15, T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B. & M. bears S. 61°15' W., a distance of 6,310 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from Mikulich Spring via a diversion dam with an outlet pipe and valve that releases water into a rock-masonry check dam 14 inches high and 10 feet wide where 100 deer and other wildlife species water within SE¼ NW¼ (Tract 44) Section 11, T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
