CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Barrel Spring for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¹ SW¹ Section 4, T.24N., R.49E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 4 bears N. 1°38' W., a distance of 3,491 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **Kenneth R. Buckingham**

Source: **Barrel Spring**

Manner of Use: **Stockwater and Domestic**

Amount of appropriation: **0.00625 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle**

Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st of each year**

Date of priority of appropriation: **December 10, 1981**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Barrel Spring via a surface spring head box thence through 250 feet of pipe to an eight foot water trough where 200 head of cattle water within SW¹ SW¹ and NW¹ SW¹ Section 4, T.24N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M., being within the JD Allotment.

The amount of water used for domestic purposes out of Barrel Spring is 4500 gallons per year.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
