CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring No. 3 for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NW¼ Section 13, T.42N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 13 bears N. 52°14'13" W., a distance of 1,796.22 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Boies Ranches

Source: Spring No. 3

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.0094 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 10, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring through open ditches and natural channels to a dirt stock pond 30 feet wide, 30 feet long and 4 feet deep where 300 head of cattle water within the NE¼ NW¼ Section 13, T.42N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Hubbard-Vineyard Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the State Engineer's Ruling #4706 dated March 1, 1999.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
