CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Leo Spring for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ Section 9, T.44N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 9 bears S. 47°44'58" W., a distance of 4,051.31 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring via a collection box thence through 200 feet of 1½-inch pipeline to a stock trough 8 feet long, 3 feet wide and 2 feet deep where 300 head of cattle water within the SW¼ NE¼ Section 9, T.44N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Hubbard-Vineyard Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the State Engineer's Ruling #4706 dated March 1, 1999.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
