CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Charlene M. Hendrickson, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation (Orchard) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SW¼ Section 23, T.16N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S¼ corner of said Section 23 bears S. 24°32'28" E., a distance of 1,388.01 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Al Pennington and Delane M. Pennington

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Irrigation (Orchard) and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.0028 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.02 acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: \*August 20, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 220 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 1 H.P. Water Ace submersible motor and pump to a 80 gallon Water Ace pressure tank, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler and drip irrigation of approximately 0.75 acres of apple orchard, located within the SE¼ SW¼ of Section 23, T.16N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 055-292-27, Washoe County, Nevada.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 20648, Certificate 6086, therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 20648, Certificate 6086.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that a change from the irrigation of an orchard to any other type of irrigation will cause this right to revert back to 4.0 acre-feet of water per acre of land irrigated.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
