CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Michael D. Buschelman, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Badger Spring for wildlife watering and habitat preservation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SW¼ Section 31, T.26S., R.61E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 15, T.28S., R.60E., M.D.B.& M., bears S. 22°16'04" W., a distance of 45,659.7 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Badger Spring
Manner of Use:	Wildlife Watering and Habitat Preservation
Amount of appropriation:	0.001 c.f.s., not to exceed 0.724 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*May 30, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Badger Spring by means of a dug hole 6 feet by 4 feet by 2 feet deep which functions as a collection pond, where wildlife water in the SE¼ SW¼ Section 31, T.26S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the manner of use of Permit 38248, Certificate 12195; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 38248, Certificate 12195.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
