CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Bellehelen Lake No. 1 for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ Section 24, T.2N., R.49E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 6, T.2N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 18°10' E., a distance of 16,700 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joe B. Fallini, Jr., Helen L. Fallini, & Susan L. Fallini

Source: Bellehelen Lake No. 1

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: \*0.032 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1000 head of cattle and 25 horses

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: May 27, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Bellehelen Lake No. 1 where 1000 head of cattle and 25 horses water within SW¼ SW¼ Section 24, T.2N., R.49E., M.D.B.& M., being within the Reveille Grazing Allotment.

\*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 52164, Certificate 16471 and any certificates issued under Permits 45379 and 45381 shall not exceed the amount sufficient to water 1000 head of cattle and 25 horses.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
