## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Ross E. de Lipkau, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 23, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 23, bears S. 77° 14' 56" E., a distance of 1,150 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	*0.0301 c.f.s., but not to exceed 21.74 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**October 14, 1957

## Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 625 feet deep, 8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 15 H.P. Hays submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to the Silver Knolls Ranch Estates Unit No. 7 located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 26, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

\*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 34762, Certificate 15389, and Permit 64232, Certificate 15455 shall not exceed 71.667 acre-feet annually.

\*\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 34764, which changed the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of Permit 17418, Certificate 5908, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 17418, Certificate 5908.

This certificate is limited to the service of lots in the Silver Knolls Ranch Estates Unit No. 7. The Silver Knolls Regional Park is not authorized to be serviced by this certificate.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is
