CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Chris C. Mahannah, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled flowing artesian well (Well #3), open channels, ponds and riparian areas for wildlife and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 9, T.32N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 9 bears N. 43°35'24" E. a distance of 458.51 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground (Well # 3)
Manner of Use:	Wildlife and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	*0.098 c.f.s., but not to exceed 70.95 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	October 28, 1998

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled flowing artesian well approximately 212 feet deep, 4-inch diameter casing, discharging underwater into a pond, thence through open channels, ponds and riparian areas for wildlife and domestic purposes within the W¼ SE¼, NE¼ SE¼, E½ NE¼ of Section 9 and W¼ NW¼, NE¼ NW¼ of Section 10, T.32N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 71-14-13, Washoe County, Nevada.

*The total combined rate of diversion and duty of water under this certificate and Permit 64555, Certificate 16499 and Permit 64556, Certificate 16500 shall not exceed 0.3743 cubic feet per second and 271.0 acre-feet annually, respectively.

*The total combined rate of diversion and duty of water under this certificate and Permit 64555, Certificate 16499; Permit 64556, Certificate 16500 and 64558, Certificate 16502 shall not exceed 0.5169 cubic feet per second and 374.2 acre-feet annually, respectively.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
