CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, George G. Lindesmith, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SW¼ Section 36, T.23N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S¼ corner of said Section 36 bears S. 75°16'24" E., a distance of 685.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, that the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Gus Willey and Hazel M. Willey
Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Irrigation and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.01 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*February 28, 1972

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 350 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 2 H.P. Sta-Rite submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for drip irrigation of approximately 3.18 acres of trees located within a portion of the SE¼ SW¼ Section 36, T.23N, R.20E., M.D.B. & M.


*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 54168 which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 30110, Certificate 10580, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 28447, Certificate 8634, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 28073, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 26589, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 26589.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that a change to conventional irrigation practices will cause this right to revert back to 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
