CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Arizona Stock Well), pump and distribution system for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 23, T.33N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 23 bears N. 33°58' E., a distance of 1,034 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground (Arizona Stock Well)
Manner of Use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	November 6, 2001

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 546 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 2 H.P. Franklin motor and Grundfos submersible pump, thence through 525 feet of 1½" pipe to a pressure tank and stock tank where 500 head of cattle water within the NE¼ NE¼ Section 23, T.33N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
