CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, B.J. Vasey, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation (landscaping) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ NW¼ Section 10, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 10 bears N. 29°52' W., a distance of 2,937 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of Use:	Irrigation (landscaping) and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.008 c.f.s., but not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*April 14, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 160 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3 H.P. Berkley submersible pump and Franklin motor, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler and drip irrigation of lawn, trees and associated landscaping, including pond level maintenance, located within a portion of the SE¼ NW¼, N¼ SW¼ Section 10, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 1319-10-311-004, Douglas County, Nevada.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 64831, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 58008, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 53450, which changed the place of use of Permit 17541, Certificate 6418, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 17541, Certificate 6418.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that a change from landscape irrigation to any other type of irrigation will cause this right to revert back to 4.0 acre-feet of water per acre of land irrigated.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
