CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NW¼ Section 18, T.47N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 18 bears N. 56°52' W., a distance of 1,866 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Y-3 II
Source:	Underground (Hot House Stock Well)
Manner of Use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0125 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	April 17, 2000

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 5 H.P. Franklin submersible pump, thence to four 81-gallon pressure tanks, thence through pipelines to stock tanks equipped with float valves where 400 head of cattle water within NE¼ NW¼ Section 18, T.47N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty under this certificate and Permit 66289, Certificate 16664; Permit 66291, Certificate 16630; Permit 66292, Certificate 16666; and Permit 66293, Certificate 16667 shall not exceed the amount sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
