CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard Matulich, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River through the Steamboat Canal for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Steamboat Canal

NE¼ SW¼ Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31 bears S. 62°04' E., a distance of 3,195.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Richard T. Matulich and Betty J. Matulich

Source: Truckee River via Steamboat Canal

Manner of use: As Decreed

Amount of appropriation: *0.013 c.f.s, but not to exceed
2.0 acre-feet per season as decreed

Period of use: As decreed

Date of priority of appropriation: **December 1861

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the Truckee River through the Steamboat Canal to a lockable, screw lift gate that controls flow into a wood box where the flow is divided among a 3-inch pipeline, a 4-inch pipeline and a concrete-lined pond. Water from the two pipelines and from the pond overflow is distributed through a series of open ditches for flood irrigation of 0.50 acres of diversified pasture within the NW¼ NW¼ of Section 13, T. 18 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 040-730-02, Washoe County, Nevada.

*This certificate and Permit 51241, Certificate 15502; Permit 51242, Certificate 15503; and Permit 51243, Certificate 15504 are limited to the irrigation of 0.963 acres within the proposed place of use, being within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 40-730-02, with a total combined duty of 4.205 acre-feet as decreed, and corrects the previous total combined duty under Permits 51241, Certificate 15502; 51242, Certificate 15503; and 51243, Certificate 15504 following the rescission of Permit 51244, Certificate 15505, by letter dated January 6, 2004.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Claim 606/606A, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 606/606A.

This certificate is issued subject to continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
