**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Rachel Kryder, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation (landscaping) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**NW¼ NW¼ Section 10, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 10 bears N. 8°19'11" W., a distance of 1,178.34 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.**

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

**Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:**

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 300 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 1½ H.P. Jacuzzi Sandhandler submersible pump, through a totalizing meter to two (2) pressure tanks, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler and drip irrigation of landscaping, including grass, garden and trees, located within a portion of the NW¼ NW¼ Section 10, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 45-121-25, Nye County, Nevada.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 14576, Certificate 5329, therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 14576, Certificate 5329.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that a change from landscape irrigation to any other type of irrigation will cause this right to revert back to 5.0 acre-feet of water per acre of land irrigated.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
