CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Bear Creek for Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ Section 17, T.46N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 17 bears S. 39°56' E., a distance of 2,018 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	County of Elko
Source:	Bear Creek
Manner of use:	Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	0.5 c.f.s., but not to exceed 50.00 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	February 3, 1993

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Bear Creek by a concrete diversion structure, thence through 6-inch steel pipe to a treatment plant and 150,000-gallon storage tank, and pumped into a water distribution system to serve the Townsite of Jarbidge, Elko County, Nevada, being within the W¼ W¼ Section 16 and NE¼ SE¼ Section 17, T. 46N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and further subject to any Adjudication In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Waters of the Jarbidge River and its Tributaries.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
