CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, John H. Milton, III, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer, of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 18, T.40N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 18, bears N. 44°40' W., a distance of 6195.6 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0155 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	June 4, 2003

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 415-feet deep, 16-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 1 H.P. Sta-Rite submersible pump, thence through 20 feet of 1¼" plastic pipe to a 14 foot by 40 inch x 18 inch steel trough, where 500 head of cattle water within the SE¼ SE¼ Section 18, T.40N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
