**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Michael D. Buschelman, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hen Spring for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**NW¼ NE¼ Section 6, T.15S., R.71E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 6 bears N. 89°W., a distance of 3,825 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.**

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Date of priority of appropriation:	<b>*February 8, 1999</b>

**Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:**

**Water flows from an unimproved spring, through the natural channel and seep area for wildlife and riparian habitat preservation within the NW¼ NE¼ Section 6, T.15S., R.71E., M.D.B.&M.**


**\*This certificate changes the manner of use of Permit 64845, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 64845.**

**This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
