CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joseph Fairchild, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ Section 26, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 26, bears S. 24°11'33" W., a distance of 506.72 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0028 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1 st to December 31 st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**March 30, 1945

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 485 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system to one single family residence with pool and associated landscaping located within a portion of the SW¼ NW¼ Section 26, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 125-26-201-007, Clark County, Nevada.

*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Revocable Permit 54364 shall not exceed 13.2 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 29893, Certificate 10257, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 11255, Certificate 3232; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11255, Certificate 3232.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
