CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Elayn Briggs, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unimproved spring, for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 1, T.22N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 1, bears S. 41°47' E., a distance of 3,010 feet, situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management
Source:	Unnamed Spring
Manner of use:	Wildlife
Amount of appropriation:	0.004 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 wild horses and wildlife
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	October 22, 2001

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an unimproved spring, through the natural drainage, where 200 wild horses and other wildlife water within NW¼ SE¼ Section 1, T.22N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Clan Alpine Herd Management Area.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
