CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Milton III, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mine Spring for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SW¼ Section 5, T.43N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 5 bears N. 79°21' W., a distance of 1485.0 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **Rebel Creek Ranch Corporation**

Source: **Mine Spring**

Manner of use: **Stockwater**

Amount of appropriation: **0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.**

Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st of each year**

Date of priority of appropriation: ***January 13, 1982**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Mine Spring via a mine adit, thence through 100 feet of 1¼-inch pipe to a 4-foot by 15-inch water trough where 500 head of cattle water within the NE¼ SW¼ of Section 5, T.43N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

***This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 45205, Certificate 16143, therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 45205, Certificate 16143.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit, therefore the date of priority is the same as permit 45205, Certificate 16143.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
