CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert E. Firth, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River through the Last Chance Ditch for irrigation, domestic and stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Last Chance Ditch

SE¼ NE¼ Section 14, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14, bears N. 24°26'00" E., a distance of 1,840 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	William Ben Scott and Sandra M. Scott
Source:	Truckee River (Last Chance Ditch)
Manner of use:	Irrigation, Domestic and Stock
Amount of appropriation:	0.275 c.f.s, but not to exceed 31.68 acre-feet as decreed
Period of use:	January 1 to December 31
Date of priority of appropriation:	*October 11, 1871

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the Truckee River via the Last Chance Ditch, through laterals, headgates and ditches for flood irrigation of pasture located on 2.95 acres within the NE¼ NW¼ and 4.97 acres within the NW¼ NW¼ Section 7, T.18N., R.20E., MDB&M, being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 043-061-05, Washoe County, Nevada.


\*This certificate changes the place of use of a portion of Permit 12338, Certificate 3649, which changed the manner and place of use of a portion of Claim 408, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 408.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
