CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Sam Long, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for memorial park (cemetery) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ Section 23, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 23, bears S. 24°17'30" E., a distance of 1,736.50 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Desert Lawn Incorporated

Source: Underground

Manner of use: Memorial Park (cemetery) and domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.0833 c.f.s., but not to exceed 50.0 acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: \*November 8, 1944

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 530 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 20 H.P. Goulds pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system to the cemetery office, maintenance office, three (3) storage ponds, various areas of lawn and associated landscaping and other ancillary uses within the memorial park, located within a portion of the NE¼ SE¼ Section 23, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 125-23-703-005, Clark County, Nevada.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 42175, Certificate 12324, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 11198, Certificate 3594, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11198, Certificate 3594.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
