**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Dwight L. Smith, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well (Well #4), pump and distribution system for recreation (golf course) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**SW¼ NW¼ Section 36, T.19S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 36, bears S. 47°56'01" W., a distance of 141.27 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.**

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Date of priority of appropriation:	<b>**February 5, 1949</b>

**Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:**

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 520 feet deep, 16-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 40 H.P. motor and turbine pump, thence through a distribution system to the Shadow Creek Golf Course located within a portion of the NW¼ of Section 36, T.19S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M, being further described as within portions of Assessor's Parcel Numbers 124-36-110-003 and 124-36-510-003, Clark County, Nevada.

\*The total combined rate of diversion granted under Permit 62821, Certificate 15807; Permit 63768, Certificate 15808; Permit 63769, Certificate 15809; Permit 67043, Certificate 16888 and Permit 67846, Certificate 16889 is limited to 1.0 c.f.s.


\*\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 29614, Certificate 8885, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 12811, Certificate 4320, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 12811, Certificate 4320.

**This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
