CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, storage tank and stock tank for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SE¼ Section 13, T.34N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 13, bears S. 72°02' E., a distance of 2,329 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **Maggie Creek Ranch, LP**
Source: **Underground**
Manner of use: **Stockwater**
Amount of appropriation: **0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle**
Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st of each year**
Date of priority of appropriation: **November 6, 2001**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 867 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 5 H.P. Franklin motor and Goulds submersible pump, thence through a pipe line to two 10,000-gallon storage tanks with 1¼" discharge line into a 27-foot diameter stock tank where 500 head of cattle water within the SW¼ SE¼ Section 13, T.34N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
