

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

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WHEREAS, Mel Daines, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic (New Frontier Hotel) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ Section 9, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 9, bears S. 64°30'0" W., a distance of 110.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	0.12 c.f.s., but not to exceed 86.712 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*August 25, 1941

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 865 feet deep, 12-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 50 H.P. GE motor, turbine pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system including storage tanks and booster pumps for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes serving; guest rooms, restaurants, bars, show and meeting rooms, swimming pools and associated landscaping at the New Frontier Hotel located within portions of the S½ SW¼ Section 9 and N½ NW¼ Section 16, all in T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

****This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 42782, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 10718, Certificate 3131; therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 10718, Certificate 3131.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
