CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Daniel L. Jacquet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unimproved spring (Red Canyon Spring No. 1) for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 15, T.11N., R.22E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 15 bears N. 49°05'48" W., a distance of 4,719.01 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Red Canyon Spring No. 1
Manner of use:	*Wildlife
Amount of appropriation:	0.0002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 35 deer
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	September 11, 1991

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from the natural discharge of Red Canyon Spring No. 1 where 35 deer water within the NW¼ SE¼ Section 15, T.11N., R.22E., M.D.B. & M.

*Pursuant to NRS 533.503 this certificate is issued for the only manner of use remaining that the permittee is legally entitled to utilize for which the permit is sought.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
