CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, John A. Harrah, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Swan Spring (an improved spring), through a pipeline, ponds and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 36, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N¼ corner of said Section 36 bears N. 04°21'33" W., a distance of 3287 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	John A. Harrah Family Trust
Source:	Swan Spring
Manner of use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	*0.15 c.f.s., but not to exceed 108.6 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**August 21, 1986

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Swan Spring by collection into an infiltration trench and then conveyed through 12-inch PVC pipe to a manhole then conveyed through 18-inch PVC pipe to a waterfall feature and ditch to the 1.78 acre pond where it commingles with waters of Crummer Spring and then flows through a distribution box and pipe for flood irrigation or is pumped through a distribution system for sprinkler and drip irrigation of the following land:

- 8.86 acres in the SE¼ NW¼ of Section 36, T.19N, R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
- 2.61 acres in the SW¼ NE¼ of Section 36, T.19N, R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
- 3.93 acres in the SE¼ NE¼ of Section 36, T.19N, R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
- 5.11 acres in the NE¼ SW¼ of Section 36, T.19N, R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
- 18.14 acres in the NW¼ SE¼ of Section 36, T.19N, R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
- 7.83 acres in the NE¼ SE¼ of Section 36, T.19N, R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
- 46.48 acres**

*The water under this certificate and Permit 60082, Certificate 16931 is commingled and the total combined duty shall not exceed 112.5 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the manner and place of use of Permit 50110; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 50110.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that this certificate is totally supplemental to Claims 207 and 208½, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), and that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
