CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ross E. de Lipkau, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe, through an intake, pump, motor and pipeline for irrigation (golf course) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 2 of Section 10, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 10 bears S. 30°49'49" E., a distance of 4,575.82 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The Glenbrook Club
 Source: Lake Tahoe
 Manner of use: Irrigation (Golf Course)
 Amount of appropriation: *0.195 c.f.s., but not to exceed 64.68 acre-feet per season
 Period of use: May 1st to October 15th of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation: **1872

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of a 560-foot long, 8-inch diameter intake pipeline, equipped with a 75hp Franklin electric motor, Sta-Rite submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler irrigation of the following land:

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 43784, Certificate 13367; Permit 54170, Certificate 16947; and Permit 54171, Certificate 16948 shall not exceed 78.48 acre-feet per season for the irrigation of 31.39 acres.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 52269, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Claim V02148, Certificate 350-1, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights of Claimants and Appropriators in and to the Waters of Glenbrook Creek and its Tributaries, in Douglas County, Nevada, Case No. 859, First Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada in and for the County of Douglas, 2nd day of September, 1941; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim V02148, Certificate 350-1.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
