CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Joe Cyphers, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for recreation (Echo Canyon State Park) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 32, T.1N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N¼ corner of said Section 32, bears N. 21°11' W., a distance of 664.90 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	*0.312 c.f.s., but not to exceed 8.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	April 1st to December 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	February 5, 1992

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 140 feet deep, 14-inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump and totalizing meter to a 40,000 gallon storage tank, thence gravity fed through a distribution system to a 34 unit campground, day use area, three restrooms, trailer sanitary dump station, a permanent and a seasonal residence and associated landscaping at the Echo Canyon State Park located within the SE¼ Section 29, NE¼ Section 32 and E¼ NW¼ Section 32, all in T.1N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined rate of diversion and duty of water under Permit 34094, Certificate 10059 and permit 57149, Certificate 16949 shall not exceed 0.312 cfs and 8.0 acre-feet, respectively, of which 0.95 acre-feet may be used on an annual basis as issued under Permit 34094, Certificate 10059.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
