CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Thomas J. Hall, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ Section 2, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 2, bears S. 87°18'27" W., a distance of 596.02 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.00413 c.f.s., but not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**June 9, 1947

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 600 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 15 H.P. submersible pump and totalizing meter to a 100,000 gallon storage tank, thence gravity fed through a distribution system to one single family residence, one caretaker's residence, a club house and associated landscaping located within a portion of the SW¼ SW¼ Section 2, the SE¼ SE¼ Section 3, the NE¼ NE¼ Section 10, and the NW¼ NW¼ Section 11, all in T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 55683, Certificate 14231, Permit 55837, Certificate 14232 and Permit 60403, Certificate 16950 shall not exceed 10.59 acre-feet annually.


**This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 58263, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 11870, Certificate 4122, therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11870, Certificate 4122.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
