CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William J. Sprow, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ Section 11, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 11, bears S. 53° 49' 29" W., a distance of 949.75 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: William Jay Sprow and Patricia Irene Sprow 1997 Family Trust

Source: Underground

Manner of use: Quasi-Municipal

Amount of appropriation: 0.0055 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.0 acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: *April 14, 1958

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 135 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a Franklin motor, Flint and Walling submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler and drip irrigation of lawn, shrubs, trees and other associated landscaping located within a portion of the SW¼ SW¼ Section 11, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 1319-11-002-002, Douglas County, Nevada.

*This certificate changes the manner of use of Permit 68656, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 64831, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 58008, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 53450, which changed the place of use of Permit 17541, Certificate 6418; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 17541, Certificate 6418.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
