CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Ronald Lee Berg, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T.11N., R.43E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 29, bears S. 3°31'02" E., a distance of 764.83 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 10 H.P. Franklin pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system to 75 single family residences (SFR) / water services situated on 77 lots, located within all that portion of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Se $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, lying north of Nevada State Highway 376 except the westerly 660.5 feet, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, except that portion within the boundary of Nevada State Highway 376 and all that portion in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, lying north Nevada State Highway 376, all in T.11N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., being more commonly known as the expanded Shoshone Estates Subdivision(s), Nye County, Nevada. *The total combined duty of water under Permit 46913, Certificate 14643, Permit 49809, Permit 63488 and Permit 63489, Certificate 17033, shall not exceed 89.98 acre-feet annually.


**This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 46914, Certificate 14644, which changed the manner of use of a portion of Permit 30033, the date of priority was established in accordance with NRS 533.395(3) cancellation rescission hearing of Permit 46914, on July 30, 1986.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that this is a secondary water supply well to the water issued under Permit 46913, Certificate 14643 in the primary water supply well.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
