CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Carl D. Savely, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Wamboldt Spring, an improved spring, via a spring pipe, weir and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 14, T.9N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14 bears N. 00°30'10" E., a distance of 5,118.96 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Tuffy Ranch Properties, LLC

Source: Wamboldt Spring

Manner of Use: Irrigation

Amount of appropriation: 0.078 c.f.s., but not to exceed 39.916 acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: November 6, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Wamboldt Spring by means of an 8-inch diameter spring pipe and V-notch weir into approximately 100 feet of PVC distribution pipe and 400 feet of 4-inch perforated PVC pipe and gravity fed for flood irrigation of the following land:

0.527 acres in the SW¼ SW¼ Section 13, T.9N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.
0.379 acres in the SE¼ SE¼ Section 14, T.9N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.
2.227 acres in the NE¼ NE¼ Section 23, T.9N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.
6.846 acres in the NW¼ NW¼ Section 24, T.9N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.
9.979 acres total

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and may be supplemental to other surface water sources under claims of vested rights and is further subject to any Adjudication In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Surface Waters of the Lake Valley Hydrographic Basin (Basin 10-183) and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
