CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Alan Gaddy, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for industrial (solid waste disposal transfer station) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SW¼ Section 19, T.23S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the C¼ corner of said Section 19 bears N. 27°43'40" E., a distance of 490 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Republic Silver State Disposal, Inc.
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Industrial (Solid Waste Disposal Transfer Station)and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.02075 c.f.s., but not to exceed 7.5 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *May 20, 1948

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 988.0 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 30 H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system including a 350,000 gallon storage tank for industrial and domestic purposes at the Republic Silver State Disposal Transfer Station, located within a portion of the E¼ NE¼ SW¼ Section 19, T.23S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Clark County Assessor's Parcel Number 191-19-301-013, Clark County, Nevada.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 58716, which changed the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 50308, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 30463, Certificate 9950, which changed the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 26823, Certificate 8270, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 12457, Certificate 3866; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 12457, Certificate 3866.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
