CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Denys M. Koyle, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SW¼ Section 30, T.14N., R.71E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 30 bears S. 47°54'40" W., a distance of 2,987.65 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Commercial
Amount of appropriation:	0.0234 c.f.s., but not to exceed 9.21 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1 <sup>st</sup> to December 31 <sup>st</sup> of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	March 5, 1999

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 162 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with an Aeromotor submersible pump, through a totalizing meter to three-2000 gallon storage tanks, thence through a distribution system to 29 motel units and 20 RV sites at the Border Inn Restaurant/Bar located within Government Lots 8, 9, 10, 12 and within a 10 acre parcel within the W½ of Section 30, T.14N., R.71E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
