CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Sky Ranch Well #2 / SS6), pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SE¼ Section 35, T.21N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 24, T.21N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 26°00'00" E., a distance of 16,458.33 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Sky Ranch Water Service Corp.
and Washoe County

Source: Underground (Sky Ranch Well #2 / SS6)

Manner of use: Quasi-Municipal and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: *Sky Ranch Water Service Corp.
0.0110 c.f.s., but not to exceed
4.80 acre-feet annually
Washoe County
0.0579 c.f.s., but not to exceed 25.27
acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st
of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: **November 17, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 283 feet deep, 12-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 40 H.P. motor and Berkeley submersible pump, totalizing meter and storage tanks, thence through a distribution system to various subdivisions and commercial services within the Sky Ranch Service Area within the place of use described in Exhibit "1".

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 60780, Certificate 17135, and Permit 65765, Certificate 17136 shall not exceed 30.07 acre-feet annually.

*The total combined duty of water that may be diverted from Sky Ranch Well #2 / SS6, under Permits 65765, Certificate 17136; 65766, Certificate 17137; and any certificate issued under 60544 shall not exceed 680.53 acre-feet annually.


*The total combined duty of water under Permits 59846, Certificate 17133; 60778, Certificate 17134; 60780, Certificate 17135; 65765, Certificate 17136; 65766, Certificate 17137; and any certificates issued under Permits 60543, 60544, and 60545 shall not exceed 716.06 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 60779, which changed the manner and place of use of a portion 31393, Certificate 9099, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 30152, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 27139; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 27139.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
