**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Frank Walter Pedlar, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring, an improved spring, via a horizontal spring pipe, concrete abutment, pump and distribution system for irrigation (landscape) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**SE¼ SE¼ Section 8, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 8 bears S. 24°45'52" E., a distance of 982.62 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.**

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **Frank W. & Coral E. Pedlar**  
Source: **Unnamed Spring**  
Manner of use: **Irrigation (landscape)**  
Amount of appropriation: **0.10 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.64 acre-feet annually**  
Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st of each year**  
Date of priority of appropriation: **\*April 19, 1996**

**Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:**

Water is diverted from unnamed spring by means of a 5 foot diameter steel pipe and concrete abutment impounding in excess of 10,000 gallons of water which is then pumped by a 1½ H.P. Hayes pump through a totalizing meter to a 35-gallon pressure tank, thence through a distribution system to frost-free hydrants and drip tubing for landscape sprinkler and drip irrigation of small lawn areas and trees located with a portion of the E¼ SE¼ Section 8, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.


**\*This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 66272, which changed the place of use of Permit 62062; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 62062.**

**This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that a change from landscape irrigation to any other type of irrigation will cause this right to revert back to 4.0 acre-feet of water per acre of land irrigated.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
